- In order to promote e-governance in various field of work, Government of Maharashtra had constituted an award for **Best IT enabled organisations in the**

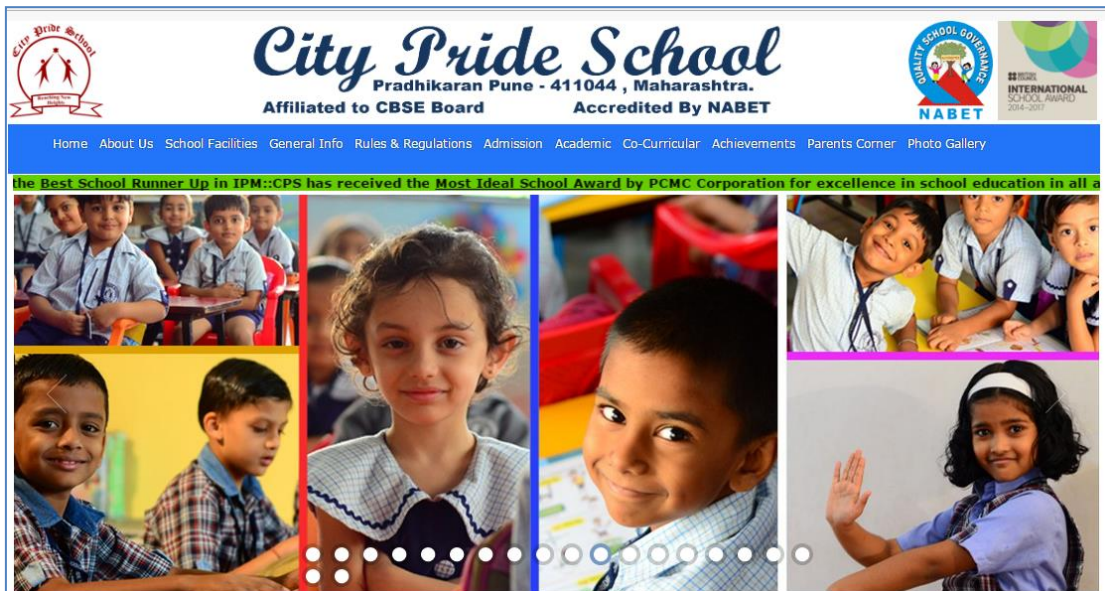

## Infrastructure Details

- **Smart class rooms with Wi-Fi campus** - City Pride School has state of art classrooms equipped with LCD projectors and Computers in each class. The entire school is Wi-fi connected with internet connectivity available even in the classrooms .Teachers regularly use Computers for teaching learning and evaluation process. The school has implemented ERP system for effective learning management system

The school has installed CCTV camera on all the school gates and also GPS system in school bus for security.

- **Computer Labs-** To keep pace with advanced technology and to use computers as an application tool ,two computer labs are available with internet connectivity .
- **Robotics Lab** - The school has established state of art Robotics lab in association with Think Labs from IIT Mumbai. The lab consists of as many as 12 robokits and visual programming facility.
- **Animation and Gaming lab** - A separate well equipped animation lab has been developed by school with high end hardware , software and other accessories .An experience trainer from animation industry has been appointed to impart practical knowledge to students for creating animated films and games. Students have created amazing films which are displayed at annual exhibition.
- **Fashion Design lab-** The students design and stitch clothes & accessories with latest stitching machines. Qualified fashion designers are appointed for guiding children

- **Electronic Lab** –A well equipped electronics lab is available to students.
- **CREYA Lab** - We at school have already introduced experiential learning program which revolves round STEAM - skills of Science Technology, Engineering , Art and Mathematics. These skills help in developing problem solving and critical analysis and prepare students to think out of box so that students can apply knowledge to solve real life problems. A special lab with tabs and manipulates has been made available for children wherein they design different structures. Students work in groups and presents their presentations.
- **Advance Mechanics Lab** – School as developed mechanical engineering lab with the facility of Computer aided design. The 3D printer in the school for manufacturing the actual prototypes of designs prepared by students. Various mechanical engineering concepts are strengthened through use of mechanical tools in this lab.
- **Atal Tinkering Lab** - Atal tinkering laboratory is a work space where young minds can give shape to their ideas through hands on do-it-yourself mode; and learn innovation skills. Students will get a chance to work with tools and equipment to understand the concepts of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math). ATL would contain educational and learning ‘do it yourself’ kits and equipment on – science, electronics, robotics, open source microcontroller boards, sensors and 3D printers and computers. Other desirable facilities include meeting rooms and video conferencing facility. Under ATL we have conducted various activities & workshops since the commencement of this lab in our school.

- Connected to Atal Tinkering Lab, F1 in schools Competition, organised by Times of Sports, at Billabong High International School, Thane: F1 in Schools is an international STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) competition for school children (aged 9–19), in which groups of 3–6 students had to design and manufacture a miniature "car" out of the official F1 Model Block using CAD/CAM design tools. Two teams of CPS participated for regional level and selected for National Level competition which is going to be held in Delhi in the month of April:
- **CAD/CAM Lab** – CAD/CAM Lab is a Computer Aided Drawing / Computer Aided Manufacturing Lab. It is a Mechanical Engineering where students will learn Graphic designing of Machine parts which are used in Automobile Industry, Manufacturing Plant, Defense Sector, etc. Additional knowledge of maths and science, innovative idea, how quality of machines are been maintained in Industry, etc.
- **Library** - The school has two well stocked libraries with thousands of books on various topics, magazines , reference books , CD collections for teachers and students.
- **Maths Lab**- To explore mathematical concepts in practical manner and create visual impact of mathematical concepts, the school has well equipped maths lab where students of class I-VIII visit regularly and learn maths enthusiastically.
- **Science Lab**- School has established three science labs which stimulates the need of students to know how things work. Along with this school has developed “Discovery lab ” with guidance from Gakken Science Academy

Japan. These labs develop little scientists and help to teach scientific principles in the most amazing way.

- **Medical room**– The school has well equipped medical room for first aid treatment. A nurse is appointed for treating medical emergency and school is connected to nearby super specialty hospital.
- **Activity room**- An activity room well equipped with toys ,Educomp smart class is available for preprimary students.
- **Seminar Hall** – School functions and parents meetings are conducted in the school seminar hall.
- **Counselors room**- to cater to learning difficulties seen among children and to help children overcome their emotional and social insecurities and achieve better confidence, school has appointed fulltime counselors.
- **Sports Ground**- The school has an in campus play ground to bring out the sporting talent of children and inculcate spirit of sportsmanship

# Education at CPS

## **Activity Based Education:**

Education at City Pride School is based on project approach with exposure through field visits, research projects, science workshops and presentations. The Continuous and comprehensive evaluation pattern [C.C.E.] is followed meticulously in the school. Recently the school has been selected by CBSE board for its pilot research project among the select 60 schools throughout the country.

The education system in our school aims at helping students in understanding the facts by working hands-on, applying simpler & investigative learning way so as to arouse interest & develop better understanding in their subject. The newly set up discovery science lab on the principals of GAKKEN education system in Japan is an appropriate example of learning science through nature.

## **Skill Development Approach**

From standard 6<sup>th</sup> onwards the school provides soft skill training to students to enhance the creativity, innovation, thinking, and problem-solving, communication skills, social & emotional learning along with essential life skills for building their confidence and leadership skills. The innovative programs make the children ready for 'out-of box' thinking and also helps in developing their all-round personalities.

Connected to this 106 students participated in National Level INTELLIGENCE PLUS INNOVENTURE organized by INNOVENTURE wherein cps students bagged various prizes and our school received an award and a Voucher of Rs. 20,000/- from Robokids for Best Enterprising School.



## Robotics

Learners of all ages enjoy hands-on construction activities. Robotics is a platform for the students where they get a chance to indulge themselves with the applications of a branch of technology that deals with day to day activities. The aim of hands on experience with engineering and mechanics provided in the robotics class is to put students in the role of creating and designing with information technology.

In Robotics Lab, students learn about different mechanisms involved in different machine and the work on how to make them automatic by doing programming. Students of Std 9 learnt to control robot through mobile app using Bluetooth technology. Students of Std 10 made integrated projects using all ATL labs.



## **Animation and gaming**

Another most popular elective that the students can choose since std. 6th is “Animation and Gaming “. A separate well equipped animation lab has been developed by school with high end hardware, software and other accessories .An experience trainer from animation industry has been appointed to impart practical knowledge to students for creating animated films and games. Students have created amazing films which are displayed at annual exhibition. Under Animation, the school students designed the images for the 8th “Doodle for Google” competition, Google invited kids to create Doodles for the given theme –“If I could teach anyone anything, it would be.....”

## **Electronics**

Electronic is the modern application of physics. It is the foundation for automation and technology along with learning basic principles of electronics through hands on experiment. Children prepare useful electronic products. Recently our students participated in the Ignited Minds Challenge supported by INTEL was organized in Hyderabad by Creya Learning. It was a National level competition cum exhibition. City Pride School got selected as one of the National level challenger team. The team made a project called EASE – Environmentally Agile Smart Electronic Device. Our school team got felicitated as National level challenger team, the goodies students got certificates and school got a trophy and a certificate too.

## Environment Awareness

### FIELD VISIT TO GHORADESHWAR (SEED PLANTATION ACTIVITY) - CLASS VII



- **PLASTIC COLLECTION DRIVE:**

In accordance to appeal by PCMC under the campaign 'Swachata hi Seva' students were asked to collect the single use waste plastic from their homes and neighbourhood and deposit the same in the school between 25th Sept 19 to 2nd October 19. It was an appeal to the entire school from L.KG to Class X. The collection from each class was done by the students of Class X under their Seva project. All the collected plastic was then handed over to the concerned people of PCMC 'A-ward' on 2nd October 2019. The garbage van from PCMC was called in the school premises for the collection. Many students as well as teachers contributed a lot towards this collection drive and helped a bit in eradication of waste plastic.

- **Rally**

The students of class IX participated in the rally for creating awareness and reinforcement for conservation of the environment by saying no to the use of plastic on 2nd October 2019. The students from all the four divisions carried some banners displaying the plastic things that are banned as well as allowed by the government and also few banners about environment. They also collected the plastic that was lying on the roadside. After the rally the ministers of class IX along with Mr. Sagar Deshpande handed over the collected plastic to the concerned people from 'A-ward'.

- **Cleanliness Drive**

As part of daily activity 'Cleanliness Drive' is conducted throughout the year in the school. Every day one class cleans the area allotted to them in groups along with the teachers which enables them to value any kind of work and develops a habit of keeping their surrounding clean.

- **Seed Plantation**

The students of class VII visited the Ghoradeshwar temple in the monsoon for field visit. The students were told to bring different seed that can be planted on the mountains. Seeds like mango, tamarind and some flowering plant seeds were planted in few places whereas rest were scattered randomly on the mountain.

- **Daily Dump (Compost)**

The students of class VII do this activity of daily dump or compost using the breakfast that is left along with the coconut choir (fibre ) and microbes. All these thing things are mixed and moistened using water, and then are added to the compost pot on daily basis. This is done with the help of the teachers from

Environment Committee. Once the compost gets ready it will be added to the plants.

- **Session on Environment Awareness**

Session to create and reinforce awareness on protecting environment and live a sustainable life was conducted on 4th October by “I-volunteer” in collaboration with Cummins India under the campaign “Coach them young”. The volunteers Ms. Roshni Acharya (I-Volunteer) and Mr. Hiren (IBM) had an interactive session on need to protect our environment by showing few videos and discussion after it. There was also a question- answer session at the end of the session, where these volunteers answered all questions posed by our students.

- **Helping hands**

We staff and students of City Pride School took a lead in helping the people affected by floods in Sangli. It was organized by Omkar Tarun Mandal, Lonavala. Value education plays a major part in child's life. It helps the children to learn to live the right way of life. It cannot be just taught by reading books. Experiential learning is what is required. A kit was provided for more than 150 houses.



## **Innovative Activities**

### **Journalism**

City Pride School has undertaken another innovative activity called “Journalism”. We believe that journalism is an attitude and not merely a profession!! A team of “School Journalist “are trained with basics of Journalism by experts. This team publishes a newspaper called “Quest” which covers news and articles related to Global , National , City and school level. School journalist team exhibits high commitment and confidence towards this noble cause. This activity has developed students vigilance , observant nature and self confidence.

### **Electronic Voting Software for election:**

City Pride School is always a step ahead in providing experiential learning to its students. The school has a Student Council Department which constitutes the elected members that represent the students and participate in various activities, acting as proactive leaders, volunteers into various programmes organized in the school throughout the year. This is to give a lesson in good governance and

democratic practices to the students. Each year the students of City Pride vote using the traditional paper ballot method. However this year computer department created software wherein students and teachers voted together and the results were declared immediately.

According to the school procedure, election guidelines are displayed everywhere in the school. Students Council Department nominated the students based on their academic performance, behavior and extracurricular activities. The nominated students declare their symbols and agenda to the voters, as it happens in real life. Then the election dates are declared. Students as well as teachers vote for the school ministers as well as head boy and Head Girl. The results are declared in the last week of April. The elected members are felicitated and sworn in an elaborate ceremony – The Investiture Ceremony in June.

### SMART SCHOOL BAG:

Normally children while packing their school bags forget to pack according to the timetable .So our City Pride School students came up with an innovative idea of **SMART SCHOOL BAG** wherein each and every book had a QR code and a predefined timetable was in the mobile App. In this App incase the student forget any book according to the timetable an alert message was sent to the parent. This project was presented in SMART SCHOOL HACKATHON , Interschool project Competition organized by Persistent.



### International Design Olympiad:

International Design Olympiad was organized by Design Derivatives to inspire students to build creative confidence through Design and Design thinking. It is a platform for young minds to embark upon a creative journey, to explore the application of knowledge gained in school and apply it to solve real world challenges.

There were 3 rounds. 760 students participated from 20 different schools.

Round 1 was conducted in school on 10th July in which 15 questions were to be attempted in 2 hours Among 80 students participated in 1st round from City Pride School, 18 got selected for 2nd Round.

Round 2 was conducted on 10th September'19. Many activities were conducted in Groups like making an innovatine umbrella, lunch box or a tray using simple things



like cardboard , tape, ice cream sticks etc. Among 18 students participated in 2nd round from City Pride School, 2 got selected for 3rd Round.

Round 3 was conducted on 10th Oct.'19. It was project based round. Students needed to design a solution to the everyday problem that they see around them. (Almost daily!)

2. Nandana Rajesh- 8th Hope

- Bhagyashree designed a schoolbag with a weight indicator and had provision for weight distribution .
- Nandana had an idea of vertical kitchen trolleys which utilize the wall space instead of floor space.

Both the ideas were presented well .



Bhagyashree received the winner trophy for Category Std 9 & 10, medal and certificate and Nandana got the medal and Appreciation certificate.

## Cultural Activities

With our vision to develop enlightened citizens, the school gives special emphasis on developing cultural and creative instincts among our children. On a regular basis, through the daily assembly significance of the day is mentioned to help them improvise their knowledge. The School has developed various creative clubs where we systematically train them for various Indian forms of art like Bharat Natyam, Kathak, Western Dance ,Harmonium , Tabla and Indian classical singing from standard first onwards. Students appear for GandharvaMahavidyalaya examinations through school. Expert coaches with “Visharad” are appointed for honing these skills
